- Look for places where your surname is most common

- Check immigration records for possible emigration city

- Use the town names where your ancestors lived in the U.S. e.g. Gretna, N.Y.; Elgin, IL; Ayr, NE

- Reasons for coming to America can help explain where they settled

## Scotland's Places www.scotlandsplaces.gov.uk

- Tax rolls live at the National Records Office and include the following types of taxes
  - Carriage Tax
  - Male/Female Servant Tax
  - O Window Tax (applied to homes with more than 7 windows or a rental value above £5)
  - O The entire collection has been digitized and is available here.
  - Post-Union taxes (after 1707) were managed by the Exchequer and can be found in that record group
- Ordnance Surveys and Name Books
  - Represent 1700 books compiling every place, both man-made and natural, named in the Ordnance Survey maps drawn in Scotland from the 1840s to 1878
  - O Shows owners of property as well as a description of the land and occasionally tenants
- Gazetteers and Directories
  - o 1892 Counties & Parishes
  - Atlas of Scottish History to 1707

#### Criminal Records.

- Types of courts:
  - o Franchise Court Local court ruled on small cases like rioting, scandal, and theft
  - Justice of the Peace- Local court handling cases like poaching, illegal fishing and prostitution
    - Prisoner records from 1840-1870 are kept by the Home Health Department.
      Records include height, weight, age. date and place of birth, and marital status
    - While the vast majority of these records are not available online, the National Archives of Scotland website has some thorough guides plus accurate search capabilities on their website
  - Most records for Jacobites, Covenanters & others groups who bore arms against the British Government are kept at the National Archives in London

#### Military Records:

Pre 1707 records are housed at the National Archives of Scotland. Post 1707 are at the U.K. National Archives in London. Records are listed by military regimen/company/troop.

Commissions were granted by the crown starting in 1670 and are in Exchequer Warrant Books.
